



## Canine Preventative Health Care Plan



3 - 4 weeks old: Intestinal Parasite Deworming

7 - 8 weeks old: Intestinal Parasite Deworming  
1<sup>st</sup> DA2PPC\* vaccination  
Start flea and tick control

10-12 weeks old: Intestinal Parasite Deworming  
2<sup>nd</sup> DA2PPC\* vaccination  
1<sup>st</sup> Bordetella\*\* vaccination

14-16 weeks old: Intestinal Parasite Deworming  
3<sup>rd</sup> DA2PP\* vaccination  
2<sup>nd</sup> Bordetella\*\* vaccination  
Rabies vaccination  
Start Monthly Heartworm Prevention

4 - 6 months old: Spay (female) or Neuter (male)

Yearly: Physical Examination  
DA2PP\* vaccination  
Bordetella\*\* vaccination  
Rabies vaccination  
Annual Heartworm Test  
Dental Cleaning

Seniors Yearly Recommendations  
Age 7 or older: Screening Bloodwork  
Chest and Abdominal X-Rays

## NUTRITION

- Have clean drinking water available at ALL times
- Feed a consistent, puppy/growth formula for first 1-2 years  
(We recommend *Science Diet Healthy Advantage Puppy*)
- Feed a consistent, quality adult diet after 1-2 years of age  
(We recommend *Science Diet Healthy Advantage Adult*)
- Feed a consistent, quality senior diet after 7 years of age  
(We recommend *Science Diet Healthy Advantage Senior*)
- Avoid table scraps and non-healthy treats  
(We recommend *Science Diet T/D* as tasty dental treats)
- Appropriate diet and exercise will lead to a better quality of life for your pet

\* DA2PPC- vaccination for Distemper virus, Adenovirus type 2, Parinfluenza virus, Parvovirus, & Coronavirus  
(Coronavirus given at ages 7-16 wks)

\*\*Bordetella vaccination to help protect against upper respiratory-like flu (Required by many groomers & boarding facilities)
