Kitten Vaccination Schedule

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|-------------|--|
| 4-6 weeks | Deworm |
| 8-10 weeks | Deworm FVRCP vaccine FeLV vaccine* FIV/FeLV testing** Start Flea/Tick Prevention |
| 12-14 weeks | Deworm FVRCP vaccine FeLV vaccine** Continue Flea/Tick Prevention |
| 16-18 weeks | Deworm FVRCP vaccine Rabies vaccine Continue Flea/Tick Prevention |
| 20 weeks | FVRCP vaccine- doctor’s choice |

FVRCP: Core vaccine; Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, and panleukopenia.

*FeLV (Feline Leukemia): Noncore vaccine: Highly recommended for kittens as they are more susceptible than adult cats to develop severe infection. 2 series vaccine.

**FeLV/FIV testing: both are viral diseases that spread from cat to cat; can be very detrimental to a cat’s overall health and longevity. Always a good idea to test kittens before introducing to other cats in the home to prevent spread of disease.
