



## Canine Preventative Health Care Plan

<b>3 - 4 weeks old:</b>	Intestinal Parasite Deworming
<b>7 - 8 weeks old:</b>	Intestinal Parasite Deworming 1st DA2PPC* vaccination Start flea and tick control
<b>10-12 weeks old:</b>	Intestinal Parasite Deworming 2nd DA2PPC* vaccination 1st Bordetella** vaccination
<b>14-16 weeks old:</b>	Intestinal Parasite Deworming 3rd DA2PP* vaccination 2nd Bordetella** vaccination Rabies vaccination Start Monthly Heartworm Prevention
<b>4 - 6 months old:</b>	Spay (female) or Neuter (male)
<b>Yearly:</b>	Physical Examination DA2PP* vaccination Bordetella** vaccination Rabies vaccination Annual Heartworm Test Dental Cleaning
<b>Seniors Age 7 or older:</b>	Screening Bloodwork Chest and Abdominal X-Rays

## NUTRITION

- Have clean drinking water available at ALL times
- Feed a consistent, puppy/growth formula for first 1-2 years
  - (We recommend Science Diet Healthy Advantage Puppy)
- Feed a consistent, quality adult diet after 1-2 years of age
  - (We recommend Science Diet Healthy Advantage Adult)
- Feed a consistent, quality senior diet after 7 years of age
  - (We recommend Science Diet Healthy Advantage Senior)
- Avoid table scraps and non-healthy treats
  - (We recommend Science Diet T/D as tasty dental treats)
- Appropriate diet and exercise will lead to a better quality of life for your pet

\* DA2PPC- vaccination for Distemper virus, Adenovirus type 2, Parinfluenza virus, Parvovirus, & Coronavirus (Coronavirus given at ages 7-16 weeks)

\*\*Bordetella vaccination to help protect against upper respiratory-like flu (Required by many groomers & board)
