FVRCP: Core vaccine; Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, and panleukopenia.

<sup>\*</sup>FeLV (Feline Leukemia): Noncore vaccine: Highly recommended for kittens as they are more susceptible than adult cats to develop severe infection. 2 series vaccine.

<sup>\*\*</sup>FeLV/FIV testing: both are viral diseases that spread from cat to cat; can be very detrimental to a cat's overall health and longevity. Always a good idea to test kittens before introducing to other cats in the home to prevent spread of disease.
